Courthouse Dogs

Courthouse dogs are professionally trained facility dogs that are graduates from an accredited service dog organization such as *Courthouse Dogs Foundation* headquartered in Bellevue, Washington. Testifying in court is an unfamiliar and stressful event for most people, especially children. These dogs are used in a courthouse setting to help reduce witness or victim anxiety and are available to any witness who requests one. Most are Golden or Labrador Retrievers. They are handled by criminal justice professionals such as a deputy prosecutor, a law enforcement officer, a victim advocate or a forensic interviewer.



Since 2003, facility dogs have provided comfort to abused children who must undergo forensic interviews and testify in court. These dogs visit juveniles in detention facilities, greet jurors and lift the spirits of courthouse staff who often conduct their business in an adversarial setting.

Dr. Harold Dee Ivie (1927-2015)

Dr. Harold Dee Ivie, known to his friends and colleagues as “Dan”, passed away peacefully at the age of 88 on May 28, 2015.

Dr. Ivie was a native of Sand Springs, Oklahoma and a 1952 graduate of Oklahoma State University College of Veterinary Medicine. Dan served his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII where he was stationed in the Philippine Islands. His Navy service also led him to California where he eventually chose to settle on the San Francisco peninsula. Dan began his veterinary career at the *White and Morris Pet Hospital* in San Bruno where he became a partner and it became “*White-Ivie Pet Hospital*”. Dan eventually became sole owner of the well-known practice from which he finally retired in 2003.

During his 50-year career, Dr. Ivie mentored many aspiring veterinarians. He also established an endowment fund at his alma mater, OSU. Dan was a Life Member of the PVMA and served as its president in 1963.

Dan is survived by his longtime companion Patricia Richardson as well as three children and their families.

A private family service was held in Fairview, Missouri and a celebration of his life was held in Redwood City, California.


